This is an AKC Sanctioned Obedience Trial, given by a licensed Obedience Club; therefore, American Kennel Club rules and regulations will be strictly enforced.

Telegraph, Telephone, and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of the entry form without Agreement and rules on reverse side of the Official AKC entry form are NOT ACCEPTABLE.

Entries without fees will not be accepted. Acknowledgment of entries will be made as soon as practical with tickets and/or identification card. The person accompanying the dog must show tickets of admission and identification before the dog will be received.
